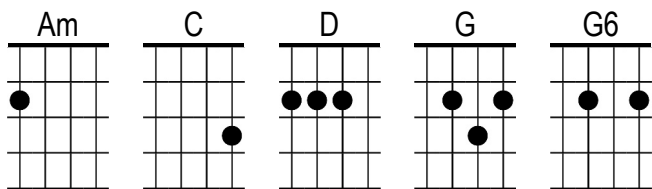


Beverly Hillbillies Theme
