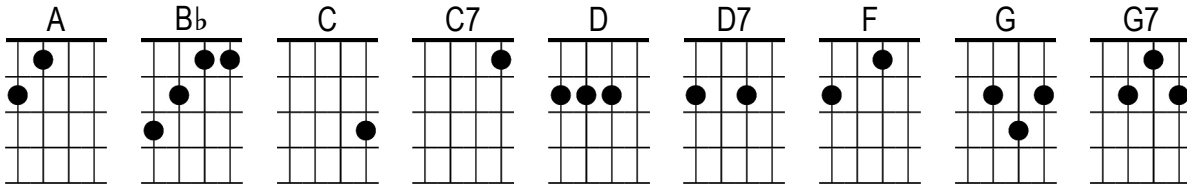


Chatanooga Choo Choo
