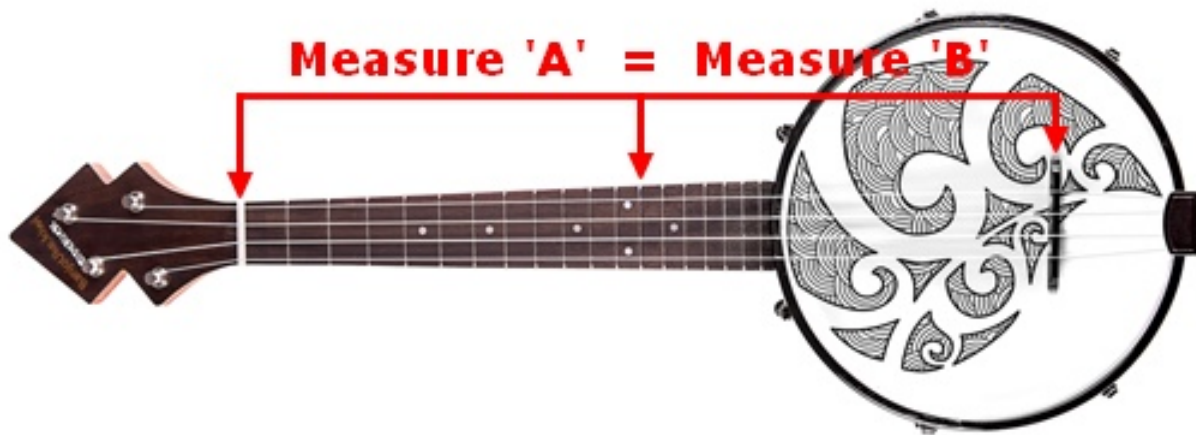


How To:

Position Your BanjoUke Bridge



Step 1:

Measure from the nut to the 12th fret (Measure 'A').

Step 2:

Position the bridge on the head the same distance from the 12th fret as the measurement in *Step 1* (Measure 'B').

Step 3:

Tune your BanjoUke.

Step 4:

Fret at the 12th fret and listen whether a note played is an octave higher than without fretting. If the note is flat, move the bridge slightly toward the neck. If the note is sharp, move the bridge slightly toward the tail piece. Repeat *Step 3*. If everything sounds fine, proceed to *Step 5*

Step 5:

Mark the position of the bridge on the head with a pencil or with some other marker so the bridge can be easily repositioned if moved.
