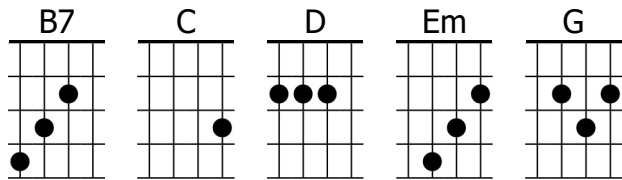


I Heard The Bells On Christmas Day
