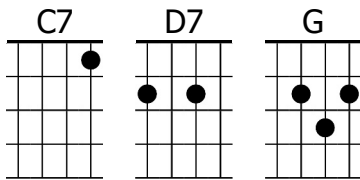


Peaches In The Springtime
