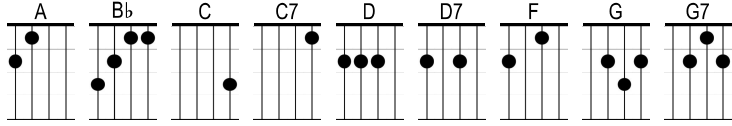


# Chatanooga Choo Choo
