# Use Chord Substitutes

Sometimes it's difficult to move your fingers into position to play a required chord. This could be due to a number of reasons:

- You're a new player and can't get your fingers into position
- You don't remember the chord fingering
- The song is played at a speed that doesn't allow you to move your fingers quickly

In these cases you may want to consider using one of the following Chord Substitutes:
